Getting There From Denver: I-70 west to Frisco, Leave I-70 at Exit # 201. Turn right into the parking lot when you reach the stop sign at the bottom of the ramp.

Maps: National Geographic Trails Illustrated # 108E. IMPORTANT: Stay found with the aid of a topographic map, a compass, a GPS receiver and the skill to use them.

Trail Description: The North Ten Mile Creek Trail # 37 begins at a fairly steep pitch, but soon levels out into intermittent meadows and woods. The trail soon enters the Eagles Nest Wilderness and follows a beautiful stream heading west. The trail terminates at the north-south Gore Range Trail. Return the way you came. **TIP:** Contact the Dillon Ranger District for trail updates.

Highlights: ■ Evidence of 19th century gold and silver mining activity primarily along the first mile of the trail • Beautiful walk along a stream in the woods
